Salvation has truly come to us (Cantata 9)

Jesus' Sermon on the Mount is the subject of today's gospel reading: he teaches about the Law, its importance and the requirement upon us to follow the Law. Cantata 9 dwells effectively on this theme. Pevsner described the Grade II Church of St Bartholomew, built in the late 1830s, as "the noblest Catholic church in South Lancashire" and it provides a fine setting. The four vocal soloists and chorus are joined by an ensemble of flute, oboe d'amore, bassoon, strings and organ.
